

## Pandemic Safety Plan

Level 1: 100% Distance Learning; staff have access to campus

Level 2: ~50% of students on campus (in class) at a time

Level 3: All students in classes five days a week





Face masks must be worn at all times

Face shields are available for students who need them



Students are expected to maintain social distancing,

Reminders are posted throughout campus,



Handwashing stations have been placed around campus.

Students should wash their hands regularly.




We have established a traffic flow for students.

We have established dedicated entrances and exits.




Students will be expected to enter and exit the main building through the appropriate door.



We established dedicated stairwells for students going up to the second floor and down to the first floor.


Students will be expected to use the appropriate stairway.





Students walk clockwise in the main building.


Desk shields will be available in every classroom

Students will be seated at least four feet apart in order to comply with social distancing guidelines



Each classroom will be equipped with:

- Hand Sanitizer
- Masks
- Gloves



## Entering & Exiting Main Office

#### Entering the building:

- One family/group at a time through the west door
- Students enter from student lot at north end or rolling gate at south end
- Staff enter through the main office or the south staff parking lot

#### Exiting the building:

- Family/Parent exits office through the east door
- Students exit to student lot on north end or rolling gate on south end
- Staff exit through the main office or to the south staff parking lot

## Walking Around Campus

#### Passing Period/Outside of Class:

- One way hallways
- One way stairwells

#### Restroom Availability:

- All student and staff restrooms will be open--student restrooms will not be available during passing period, only during class time
- Marked spacing for those that are waiting
- Cleaned & sanitized after brunch, each lunch, and after school



## Table Top Surfaces

#### Staff Desks:

- Each class is supplied with hand sanitizer & cleaning spray.
- Each evening custodial staff will disinfect with sanitizing spray.



#### Student Desks:

 Desks will be designated "A" or "B" based on schedule; between student use, desks will be sanitized with sanitizing spray.

# Disinfection Protocol for all Rooms on Campus

### Grab-N-Go Lunch

## Lunch will be served between 11:05-12:20 pm daily!

 Students will receive lunch for that day and breakfast for the next morning.





## Specialized Classrooms

#### Music Room:

- Piano keyboards will be sanitized daily (currently, only one section offered)
- No shared instruments in the band room
- Room will be cleaned and disinfected daily

#### Computer Room:

Workstations will be designated "odd" or "even" based on schedule; between use, work stations will be disinfected and sanitized with sanitizing spray



## Sick Room, Hand Washing & Sanitizing

#### **Sick Room:**

Room AA40--in the intervention office

#### Hand Washing & Sanitizing:

- Portable Stations--located North, South,
  East, and Overhang
- Classrooms are supplies with hand sanitizer--teachers will sanitize hands between helping/working with different students
