2020-2021 School Year

All Lodi USD students will be participating in distance learning through at least October 2, 2020

Lodi Unified will continue to follow the guidance of San Joaquin County Public Health Services and the San Joaquin County Office of Education regarding the current status of instruction.

2020-2021 School Year

- Students who wish to remain on distance learning, regardless of the decision regarding in person instruction have been placed in digital sections.
 - These students will remain on distance learning when and if it is decided that students return for in person instruction.
- Other students have been placed in classes that will meet on campus, when and if it is decided that students return for in person instruction.
- The current schedule also includes provisions for potential hybrid schedule that includes a combination of distance and in person learning

2020-2021 School Year

- Distance learning is synchronous, meaning that students are expected to follow their normal schedule as if they were coming to campus for in person learning.
- Teachers will take attendance everyday.
- Teachers and students are expected to interact everyday.

Looking Ahead

- McNair is working with Lodi USD and Delta College to provide dual enrollment classes.
 - Dual enrollment course begin on Tuesday, September 7
 - Class times are 12:52 pm to 2:22 pm :
 - FCS 6 Nutrition Mondays and Wednesdays
 - A J 21 Criminal Justice Tuesdays and Thursdays
 - Students will have the opportunity to enroll in a college course and earn college credit free of charge.
 - Credits may be transferrable to a UC or CSU
 - Of you are interested in one or both Dual Enrollment coursed please contact your student's counselor

Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports

- The current focus for intervention and supports is on identifying students who are not participated in distance learning and providing appropriate intervention.
 - Assistants Principals, Counselors, our On Campus Intervention Teacher and our Child Welfare and Attendance Advisor have been making phone calls to students and parents who have missed multiple days of school

Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports

- During distance learning students are expected to follow the same guidelines and meet the same expectations they would if there was in person instruction.
 - This includes behavior during video conferences.

Title 1

Annual Parent Meeting

2020-2021

What is Title 1?

- To provide supplemental educational services to disadvantaged students in high-poverty public school attendance areas
- Funds are allocated based on the percentage of students whose families receive free or reduced lunch.
- Currently, the district percentage is 67.2 %

How Does a School Qualify for Title 1?

- Lodi Unified School district funds all schools who have a free and reduced lunch rate of 75% or higher.
- In the 2019-2020 school year, 25 schools qualified to receive Title 1 funds. For the 2020-2021 school year, 28 schools have qualified to receive Title 1 funds.
- Funds have been allocated to qualifying schools based on the student enrollment of each school site.
- Last year, our school was allocated \$ 185,015.00.

What Can Title 1 Funds Be Used For?

- Funds are to be used to improve the academic achievement of students
 - English Language Arts
 - Mathematics
- 1% of the Title 1 allocation must be used for Parent Involvement
 - Parent meetings
 - Parent trainings
 - Parent communication

Who Decides How the Money is spent?

- The School Site Council approves the School Site Plan and Title 1 expenditures.
- Parents have the right to provide input regarding the academic program of their student
 - Opportunities for input are provided throughout the school year at the district level and school site level.

School Site Council

- The School Site Council consists of parents, teachers, and other school staff. Students are included at the high school level.
- Each group of members must be elected by their peers.
- The role of the School Site Council is to annually develop, review, update and approve the Single Plan for Student Achievement. (The SPSA specifies how Title 1 funds will be spent)

School Site Council

- Parent representatives are elected and serve a three year term.
- There are at least four meetings scheduled every year, more is needed.

- Elections will be held via a Google Form within the next two weeks
