the Career Center. The **ASVAB** is a career exploration program to assist students in defining their skills and strengths for college and career planning. Students in grades 10 – 12 may take the **ASVAB** provided by the military free of charge. There is no military obligation.

Collegebound students should take advantage of the assistance provided by the Delta College Financial-Aid Department every Wednesday after school in the Career Center to complete FAFSA and Dream Act applications to ensure applications will be submitted before the priority deadline of March 2nd. The pool of money available will become smaller each month that goes by so please do not delay and miss out on the Cal-Grant money that you may be eligible to receive.

Delta College will be hosting two **Zoom** presentations for prospective students:

1. Step-by-step guidance to register for classes will take place on **December 6th 4:30 - 5:30**.
